The event will be held from **10 a.m. to noon Saturday, Nov. 21 at McKeesport Area High School, 1960 Eden Park Blvd.** Registration is required for this drive-up event. Reservations for this event are limited to 700 individuals and must be made by 5 p.m. Thursday, Nov. 19.

In addition to 700 turkeys, food boxes containing essential food items for a Thanksgiving meal – such as boxes of stuffing and potatoes, canned foods like gravy and cranberry sauce, vegetables and sweet potatoes – will be handed out to those who attend.
